AM Classes:

Level 1: More spelling practice would be good! Students are interested in learning more homonyms. Keep practicing foundational grammar topics like “to be, subject/object pronouns”.

Level 2: Reading out loud is good practice for students. Encourage students to respond in full sentence! More practice with possessives would be good.

Level 3: Students are very interested in knowing about their career choices and path to take. They also enjoy learning “weird” words and idioms!
